<Area 20PS> Attempted Set 3 but 2 Humpbacks approached during set, net was backhauled to avoid interaction. Could not get any more sets in due to abundance of whales in the area.

Test boat is continuing to fish August 8, but is being selective with set locations due to large abundance of whales remaining in the area.

Vessel is reporting that they are not seeing any signs of sockeye abundances building in the area at this time.

<Area 7RN> (Lummi Island) Jumpers observed in the back of the bay.

Strong ebb behind the gear, despite offshore flood.

<Area 7RN> (San Juan Ch.) Gear in San Juan Channel reported tide running strong backwards during prime observation period. Strong northerly wind all day. Reporting poor fishing conditions with the gear.

No jumpers seen.

<Cottonwood GN> Gilled vs. Tangled: Sock Adult: 156 (5), Chin Adult: 0 (3), Sturgeon: 0 (1). Small schools observed on sounder on run up river.

<Whonnock GN> Gilled vs. Tangled: Sock Adult: 37 (4), Chin Adult: 2 (1). 1 dead sockeye caught drifting downstream.

1 seal observed at net.

<Area 12 Round Island GN>

<Area 12PS> Saw a few jumpers during 6th set, but otherwise quiet.

<Area 13PS> Had a good 5th set, but net needed repairs. Could not complete 6th set.
