The Fraser Panel met Monday, July 14th to review the status of the Fraser River sockeye migration. The current estimate of Early Stuart run size remains unchanged at 25,000 sockeye. It is expected that an update on Early Stuart run size will be provided at the next Panel meeting.

Fraser River discharge levels continue to be lower than normal for this date. Water temperatures in the Fraser River are presently favorable for migrating sockeye.

The Panel will meet again Friday, July 18th.
