






2010 Survey encountered Age-O rockfish in adult salmon stomachs, bongo net, and rope trawl.


Age-O rockfish were not abundant in the 2011 survey and not a significant prey item observed in salmon stomachs.

Length of rockfish decreased in 2011 trawl catch compared to 2010.











Decapod megalope
