This position is based in the lab, in our downtown Vancouver office. There are no field duties in this position.

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Using forceps to process sockeye scales and otoliths in preparation for Scale Analysts
- Using a hydraulic press to make impressions of scales
- Data entry using Excel
- Data entry and retrieval using Access
- Preparing lab stationery as required
