The Fraser River Panel met Tuesday, September 4 to receive an update on the migration of

Fraser sockeye and review the status of migration conditions in the Fraser River watershed.

At the meeting today, the run sizes remained unchanged for Early Summer, Summer and Late-

run. Test fishing catches indicate 94% of the Fraser sockeye are currently passing through

Johnstone Strait.

On September 3, the Fraser River water discharge at Hope was approximately 1,782 cms,

which is approximately 27% below average for this date. The temperature of the Fraser River at

Qualark Creek on September 3 was 16.9°C, which is 0.4°C above average for this date. Fraser

River water temperatures are forecast to remain the same at 16.9°C over the next few days.
