The Fraser River Panel met Friday, September 7 to receive an update on the migration of Fraser sockeye and review the status of migration conditions in the Fraser River watershed.

At the meeting today, the run sizes remained unchanged for Early Summer, Summer and Late-run.

On September 6, the Fraser River water discharge at Hope was approximately 1,695 cms, which is approximately 30% below average for this date. The temperature of the Fraser River at Qualark Creek on September 6 was 15.7°C, which is 0.5°C below average for this date. Fraser River water temperatures are forecast to decrease to 15.5°C over the next few days.
