The Fraser River Panel met Tuesday, July 25, to receive an update on the migration of Fraser River sockeye salmon and review the status of migration conditions in the Fraser River watershed. It is currently estimated that 125,100 sockeye have passed the Mission hydroacoustics site. The Panel made no changes to run size at today's meeting.

On July 24 the discharge of the Fraser River at Hope was 2,416 cms, which is approximately 50% below the historical average for this date. The temperature of the Fraser River at Qualark Creek on July 24 was 20.1°C, which is 2.4°C above the historical average for this date. Fraser River discharge levels and water temperatures will be monitored closely to determine if specific management actions are required during the in-river migratory period to help achieve sockeye escapement goals.

All Panel Area Waters remain closed to commercial salmon fishing.

The next in-season meeting of the Panel is scheduled to occur on Friday, July 28, 2023.
