

The Panel announced the following regulations for Panel Area waters:

**CANADIAN FRASER RIVER PANEL AREA WATERS:**

Area 29-4, 29-6, 29-7 and 29-9: The Area B seine ITQ fishery for pink salmon with non-retention of sockeye salmon that was announced on Friday, September 13 has been amended to open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily from Tuesday, September 17, 2013 through Thursday, September 19, 2013. (Please refer to DFO Fishery Notice for further details).

**UNITED STATES FRASER RIVER PANEL AREA WATERS:**

Areas 4B, 5 and 6C: Relinquish regulatory control effective 12:01 p.m., Wednesday September 18, 2013.

**TREATY INDIAN FISHERY**

Areas 4B, 5 and 6C: As previously announced, extended for drift gillnets from 12:00 p.m. (noon) Saturday, September 14, 2013 through 12:00 p.m. (noon) Wednesday, September 18, 2013. Sockeye salmon may be retained for ceremonial and subsistence purposes only.

**ALL CITIZEN FISHERY:**

Area 7: As previously announced, open to reefnets with non-retention of sockeye from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily from Saturday, September 14, 2013 until further notice.

(Note: U. S. All Citizen fishers should check the U.S. hotline and WDFW regulations before fishing as there are additional State of Washington regulations, including time restrictions that may be in effect).
