

The Fraser River Panel met Friday, September 16, 2011 to receive an update on the migration of Fraser River sockeye and pink salmon.

At the meeting today there were no changes to run-sizes for Fraser River sockeye. The current adopted run-sizes are: 590,000 Early Summer-run sockeye, 1,550,000 Summer-run sockeye, 325,000 Birkenhead sockeye, 1,100,000 Harrison sockeye and 1,000,000 Late Shuswap/Weaver Creek sockeye. There was no change to Pink salmon run size of 17,500,000 fish.

The Panel announced the following regulations for Panel Area waters:

**CANADIAN FRASER RIVER PANEL AREA WATERS:**

Area 29 – 1 to 6: Area H troll continues until Friday, September 23, 2011, for the retention of pink salmon only. (**Please refer to DFO Fishery Notices for further details**).

Area 18-1, 18-4, 18-11: Area H troll continues until Friday, September 23, 2011 for the retention of sockeye and pink salmon. (**Please refer to DFO Fishery Notices for further details**).

Area 18-1, 18-4, 18-11: Area B seine continues from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily until Friday, September 23, 2011 for the retention of pink salmon only. (**Please refer to DFO Fishery Notices for further details**).

Area 29-3, -4, -6, 29-7, 29-9, 29-10: Portions of these subareas open to Area B seine from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily until Friday, September 23, 2011, for the retention of pink salmon only. (Note: This fishery will be monitored closely and could close on short notice, **please refer to DFO Fishery Notices for further details**).

**UNITED STATES FRASER RIVER PANEL AREA WATERS:**

Remains closed to fishing.
