The Fraser River Panel met Tuesday, August 16 to receive an update on the migration of the Fraser River sockeye and pink salmon.

There were no changes to run sizes at the meeting today.

The daily migration of Fraser River pink salmon is expected to increase over the next few weeks as they near their expected peak marine migration period near the end of the month.
