

The Fraser River Panel met Friday, September 02, 2011 to receive an update on the migration of the Fraser River sockeye and pink salmon.

There were no changes to run-size. The current adopted estimates of run-size are Early Summer run 520,000 sockeye; Summer run sockeye, 1,500,000; Birkenhead River sockeye 300,000; Harrison River, 950,000 sockeye; and Late Shuswap/Weaver, 1,000,000 sockeye.

There was no change to the pre-season forecast run size of Pink salmon of 17,000,000 fish. The recent three-day diversion rate of pink salmon is currently estimated to be 45%. Monitoring of the migration of Fraser River pink salmon continues.

**TREATY INDIAN FISHERY:**

As previously announced: Areas 6, 7, and 7A: Open to net fishing from 5:00 a.m. Friday, September 2, 2011 until 11:00 a.m. Sunday, September 4, 2011, in the area southerly and easterly of a straight line drawn from Iwersen's dock on Point Roberts in the State of Washington to the Georgina Point Light at the entrance to Active Pass in the Province of British Columbia.

Areas 6, 7, and 7A: Open to net fishing from 5:00 a.m. Monday, September 5, 2011 until 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 6, 2011, in the area southerly and easterly of a straight line drawn from Iwersen's dock on Point Roberts in the State of Washington to the Georgina Point Light at the entrance to Active Pass in the Province of British Columbia.

## **NON-TREATY FISHERY:**

As previously announced: Areas 7 and 7A: Open to gillnets with non-retention of sockeye from 11:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. (midnight) Sunday, September 4, 2011, in the area southerly and easterly of a straight line drawn from Iwersen's dock on Point Roberts in the State of Washington to the Georgina Point Light at the entrance to Active Pass in the Province of British Columbia.

As previously announced: Areas 7 and 7A: Open to purse seines with non-retention of sockeye from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sunday, September 4, 2011, in the area southerly and easterly of a straight line drawn from Iwersen's dock on Point Roberts in the State of Washington to the Georgina Point Light at the entrance to Active Pass in the Province of British Columbia.

As previously announced: Areas 7 and 7A: Open to reefnets with non-retention of sockeye daily from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Friday, September 2, 2011 through Tuesday, September 6, 2011.

Areas 7 and 7A: Open to gillnets with non-retention of sockeye from 8:15 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. (midnight) Tuesday, September 6, 2011, in the area southerly and easterly of a straight line drawn from Iwersen's dock on Point Roberts in the State of Washington to the Georgina Point Light at the entrance to Active Pass in the Province of British Columbia.

Areas 7 and 7A: Open to purse seines with non-retention of sockeye from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Tuesday, September 6, 2011, in the area southerly and easterly of a straight line drawn from Iwersen's dock on Point Roberts in the State of Washington to the Georgina Point Light at the entrance to Active Pass in the Province of British Columbia.
